Donations Made to Orphan Grain Train

This Spring we chose the Orphan Grain Train as our mission project. The local hub is in Ida Grove and we delivered 4 pickloads of clothing, shoes, canes, crutches, walkers and other equipment to be delivered to needy people throughout the United States and world. The Orphan Grain train is a Christian volunteer network that ships donated food, clothing, medical and other needed items to people in 71 different countries including the USA.

One recent shipment went to Ukraine. It was filled with clothing, quilts, surgical equipment, crutches and canes.

Orphan Grain train warehouses are found throughout the United States and are run by volunteers. Only 2% of everything donated is spent on administrative costs. The other 98% goes to providing necessary items for people in need.

To find out more about the Orphan Grain Train, search Google and you will find that there is very little that this organization cannot use to help the needy. Thanks to all who donated and to Jerry Klindt for taking our donations to Ida Grove. It was very much appreciated.
