We enter 2024 as the newly named Anthon Community Methodist Church. We have chosen to remain as a Methodist Church but not affiliated with the United Methodist Church Conference. We will remain an independent church for the coming year being led by a very strong Administrative Board and Staff-Parish committee.

The Lord has blessed our church in many ways this year. We have remained financially stable with very generous contributions from people near and far who show their love and support for our church.

After many years of cracked floors and walls, we were able to raise the foundation on the West side of the church and fix those cracks. We do have some cosmetic repairs to finish but overall, we solved a major problem. Thank you to those who made this possible.

With a very generous memorial, we were able to complete the walk-in shower in the parsonage to make both the church and the parsonage handicap accessible.

We increased our congregation by accepting five transfers and confirmed two young people. We baptized two babies and for the first time in many years, we did not have one funeral service in our church although I had the honor of presiding at the service of a close friend of the church and the interment of several other people connected to the church.

In the next few weeks, we will light the advent candle and hang our banners proclaiming Hope, Joy, Peace, and Love and on Christmas Eve, we will light the Christ Candle proclaiming the birth of Christ.

We will enjoy the youth of the church being part of the church service on Sunday, December 10th, giving us their own view of what Christmas is all about.

Christmas holds a sacred spot in the heart of every believer. We put out our nativity sets. We sing our favorite carols and reread the beloved scripture, the story of Mary and Joseph, their 80-mile journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem and the birth of Jesus in a manger. We are transported back in time.

We all love the cookies, the family get togethers, the gifts, the music, the time off from work, the decorations and everything that goes along with Christmas but we must never forget that the birth of Jesus is the reason for the season.


