This past year, the church has worked on many mission projects that benefit not only the local area, but also overseas projects. I want to highlight some of them this month, to let you know there are so many needy organizations that we have been able to give aid to.

The Orphan grain train based out of Ida Grove was given several pick-up loads of clothes shoes, walkers, canes, etc. 98 per cent of all gifts go directly to those in need. Most of our donations went to a semi load of items that went to the Ukraine.

This spring the Gospel Mission put out a call that they were in need of men's, women's, children's clothing, coats, shoes, any wearable items. You name it and they needed it. We ended up with about four pick-up loads of clothes that were taken to the Mission.

The Place is another Sioux City shelter that provides shelter for abused men and women. Our gift to them consisted of many blankets, personal products and usable items that they needed for apartment life and a new start.

For many years, we have given school kits and health kits to the Ingathering supported by the Methodist Church.

Cash was given to the warming shelter this winter for food or personal products for their use.

The heifer project is a continuous project where quarters and other change is collected each week and given to Heifer International for the purchase of chicken flocks, rabbits, bees, ducks, geese, pigs, cattle and other animals. We have given several hundred dollars to this project.

We also support the Angel Tree at Christmas and give groceries for the Christmas boxes.

The latest mission project is to raise money to give a gift of mobility to someone who has suffered from Polio and needs the ability to get around. So many people, especially African people have become immobile from the life-threatening disease of polio. People who have only been able to move around by crawling on the ground are now able to get around on special three-wheel mobility carts given by Mobility Worldwide. To pay for one of these carts, which costs around \$425 or a new set of wheels which costs \$80, we are joining the spring Anthon rummage with a 50-cent rummage. Everything that is donated to us for the May 31/ June 1 rummage will be sold for 50 cents and all monies will go toward purchasing a mobility cart.

Yes, it is more blessed to give than to receive and we continue to share what God has given us.
