I remember in grade school where we learned each letter of the alphabet by writing in cursive. There are children today who cannot write in cursive or even read it. For those who cannot read or write in cursive, they've missed an important way of communicating.


# Our Life Together

Deanna brought the meeting to order. The minutes of the last meeting were read. Roger moved to accept the minutes, JoLynne 2<sup>nd</sup>; all in favor, motion approved.

Pastor's Report: Made more calls than usual due to the weather. Made several nursing home visits and one

hospital visit. Did three Church Services and will be preaching more than two Sundays a month during Lent. Did four church bulletins and two children's stories. We're collecting blankets, gloves and mittens for warming shelter and Gospel Mission. Plans started for Easter baskets for shut ins and nursing home patients. Also started planning for spring rummage sale. Worked in church office three days this past week. Helped Becky and JoLynne finish March Focus. Approved hiring Mapleton Accounting Firm to take care of IRS issues. Also planning two late Sunday afternoon

movies with JoLynne's help.

Worship: Trying to have special music for Lent. Roger will sing and Erin will sing March 30th. Palm leaves

are being ordered for Palm Sunday and with smaller ones for children. Will do Good Friday

service with Sunrise Services on Easter morning.

Finance: Marilyn reported \$41,204.79 in the bank. We're keeping up with the bills.

Trustees: Discovered water drip in pipe line coming from the well. Pressure switch was leaking so had a

plumber install a new switch. Need to replace ballast in light fixtures.

Teaching: Both Kathy's children and Tim's adult groups are going fine.

Outreach/Missions: Jerry took items to Gospel Mission and warming shelter. "Sleep in Heavenly Peace" is an

organization that makes beds for children. They send an Easter Tree to area churches. Roger moved that instead of accepting an Easter Tree we send \$200; Marilyn 2<sup>nd</sup>; all in favor, motion

passed.

Nurturing/SPRC: Nothing to report.

Women of Faith: Nothing planned for March.

Old Business: Riley cleared snow out front and Cy cleared sidewalks.

JoLynne moved the meeting close with 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mark; all in favor, motion passed.

Meeting ended with a prayer by Lay Pastor Shirley.

Next meeting will be April 14th at 4:30 p.m. JoLynne will have devotions.
